Current Safer Worship Plan

- Keep a 6 foot social distance. This is required in order to comply with Kansas guidelines.
- No handshakes or hugs. Greet people with a smile and a wave.
- Please don't congregate in aisles, walkways, or lobbies. Visiting outside would be great.
- Feel free to wear masks, and disposable masks will be available at the church.
- Hand sanitizer will be stationed around the church.
- A couple of people have volunteered to be door openers.
- There won't be greeters, but there will be a stack of bulletins you can help yourself to.
- Since we're required to spread out, every other pew has been cordoned off with hymnals.
- There won't be a greeting time during the service, and I won't greet everyone on the ramp.
- We won't have a children's message during worship at least through June.
- We will use baskets near the exits to collect the offering instead of passing offering plates.
- Feel free to leave worship early in order to minimize contact with people.
- The nursery won't be staffed through June, but parents can still use it and the Cry Room.
- The card-signing table will be closed, but cards are still being sent.
- The playground will be open, so parents may want to plan ahead of time regarding that.
- There won't be Coffee Time at least through June.
- Sunday School for children and youth is canceled through June.
- For adult Sunday School, the decision to meet or not is being made by each class.
- Those who are more vulnerable to the virus may want to consider staying home.
- The worship service will continue to be steamed online.
- If you feel sick (cold symptoms, cough, fever, etc), please stay home and worship online
